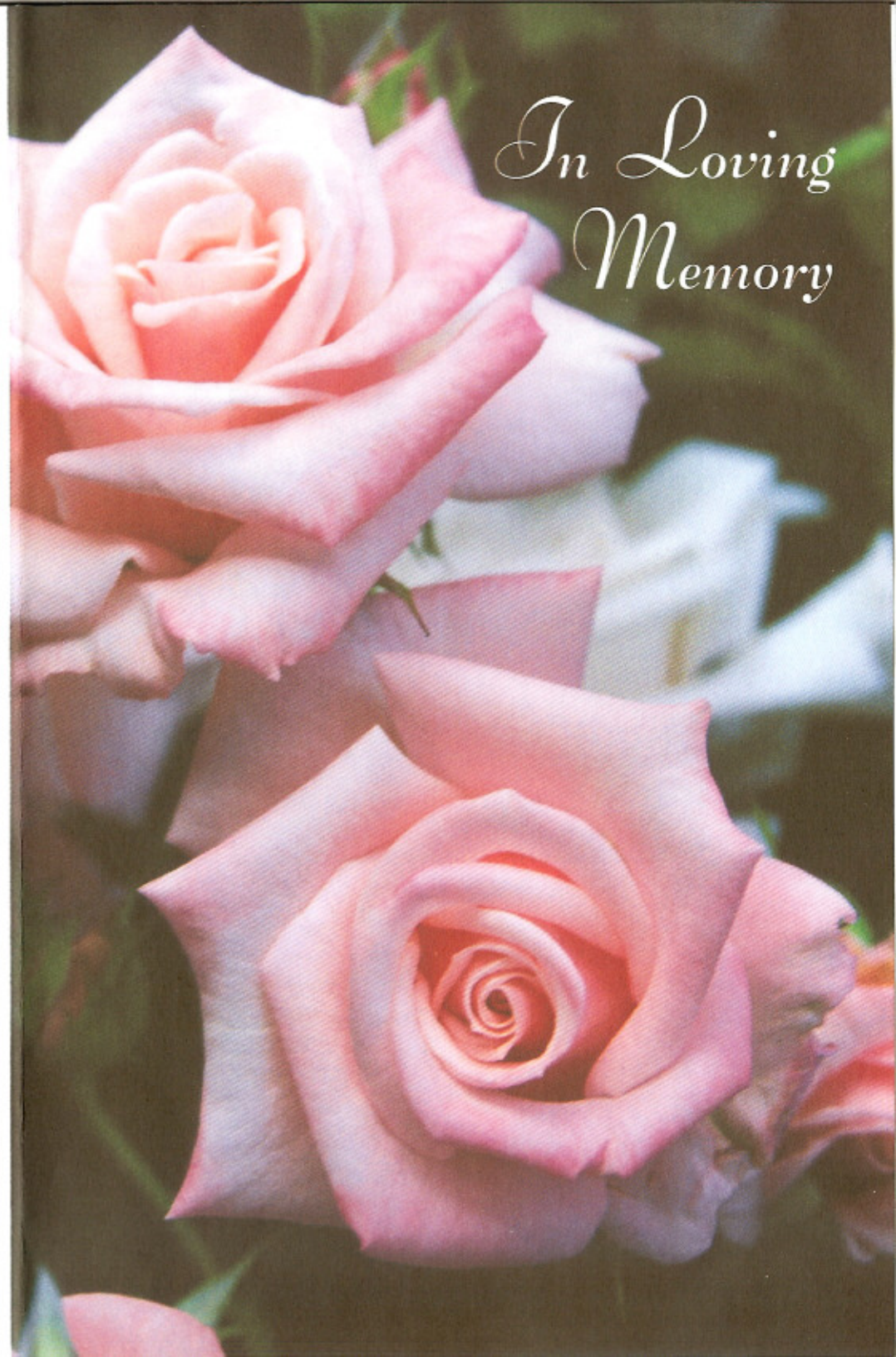


August 28, 1936 ~ May 19, 2007
